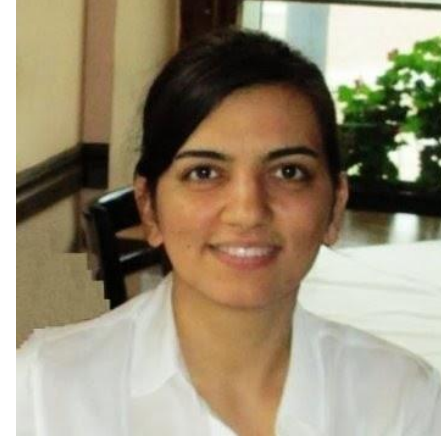
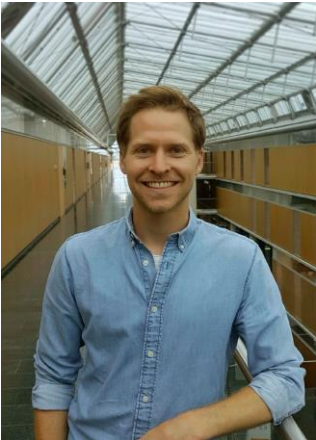
Professor of Public Policy at ETH Zurich

European governments are struggling to accommodate large numbers of refugees from Ukraine, Syria and other countries, yet there exists a scarcity of evidence on how asylum policies and processes affect their subsequent integration in the host country. This presentation will use several case studies to show how insights from quantitative social science can be used to evaluate existing and design new policies to improve refugee integration.

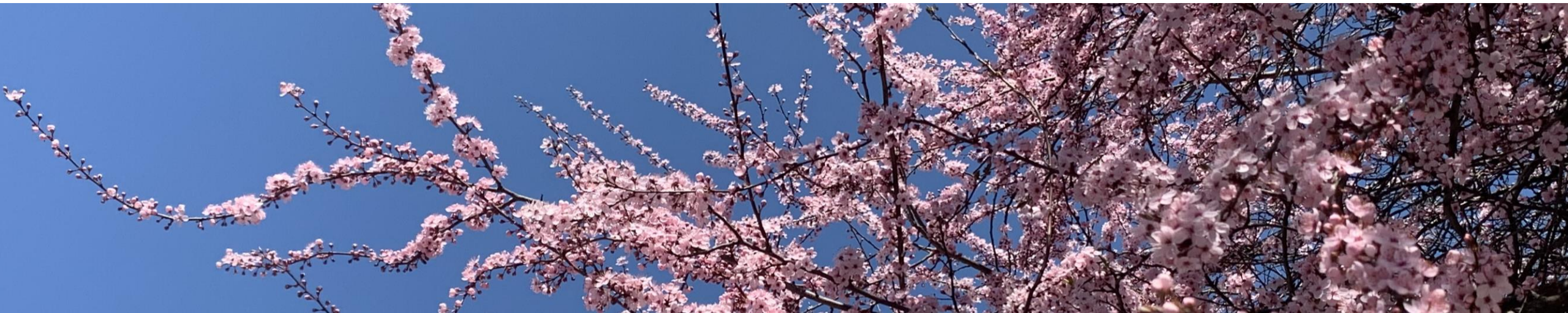
