



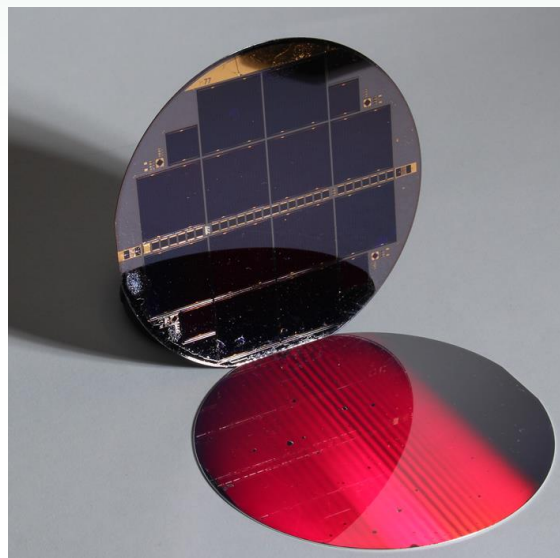

Transition of the Energy System and the Impact of Photovoltaics

Climate change is one of the most challenging tasks facing mankind. In order to reduce harmful CO₂ and other greenhouse gases, the energy supply must be converted from today's fossil-based energy sources to a renewable energy supply.
